Notes - From *The Daily Mail*, "Error by Phoenix and Howard Loses Another Game 3-2...Tough Luck for the Poor Boy That His Teammates Are So Careless...Came in the Ninth...Did Boot That Permitted the Winning Run to Score - Pretty Pitchers' Battle With Honors Even."

In a pitchers duel between the Terriers ace, Earl Howard and the Ponies twirler, Longacre, the two clubs battled to a 2-2 tie going into ninth, with the game looking like it could go extra frames. However, with two outs in the ninth and Leo Seiffert on third, a misplay by second baseman Bill Phoenix on Muff Oyler's sharp grounder, allowing Seiffert to score, as Oyler beat out the throw to first and give Gettysburg a 3 to 2 victory.

Mike "Eddie" Copeland knocked in both of Gettysburg's earlier runs on base hits in the third and fifth innings. Hagerstown tied the game at one in the fourth when Monk Walters scored on Doherty's two bagger. After the Ponies added a run, the Terriers retied it in the sixth on Jack Hurley sacrifice fly, scoring Charles Dysert, who reached on a double, from third.
